The LaVale Civic Improvement Association (LCIA) was formed in 1946 when the population was growing rapidly. The organization serves as a liaison for our residents to various government agencies. Our goal is to maintain and improve the quality of life in LaVale through the diligent efforts of the residents and property owners in our mountain community.

The Braddock Run Watershed Association (BRWA) was initially formed in 2005 to address the problems caused by the damaging floods that had occurred in LaVale, and a few years later the two organizations merged their monthly meetings into one. The LCIA and BRWA partnership has been a great asset to LaVale.
